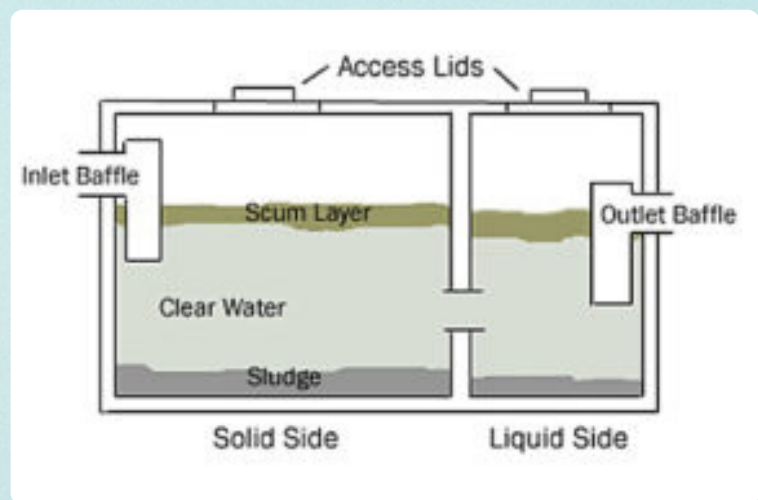


Baffles & How They Work



The inlet baffle directs the flow of water to the bottom of your tank so the water does not exit the tank too quickly and to give the waste a longer time to separate from the waste water. The outlet baffle helps keep the solids from exiting the tank and not flowing into the drain field or leach lines.

There are two baffles on your septic tank; one at the inlet side (where the waste water comes into the tank from your house) and one at the outlet side (where the waste water goes out into your drain field).



Maintaining your baffles could make the difference in spending thousands of dollars on drain field repairs, extensions, or replacements.
