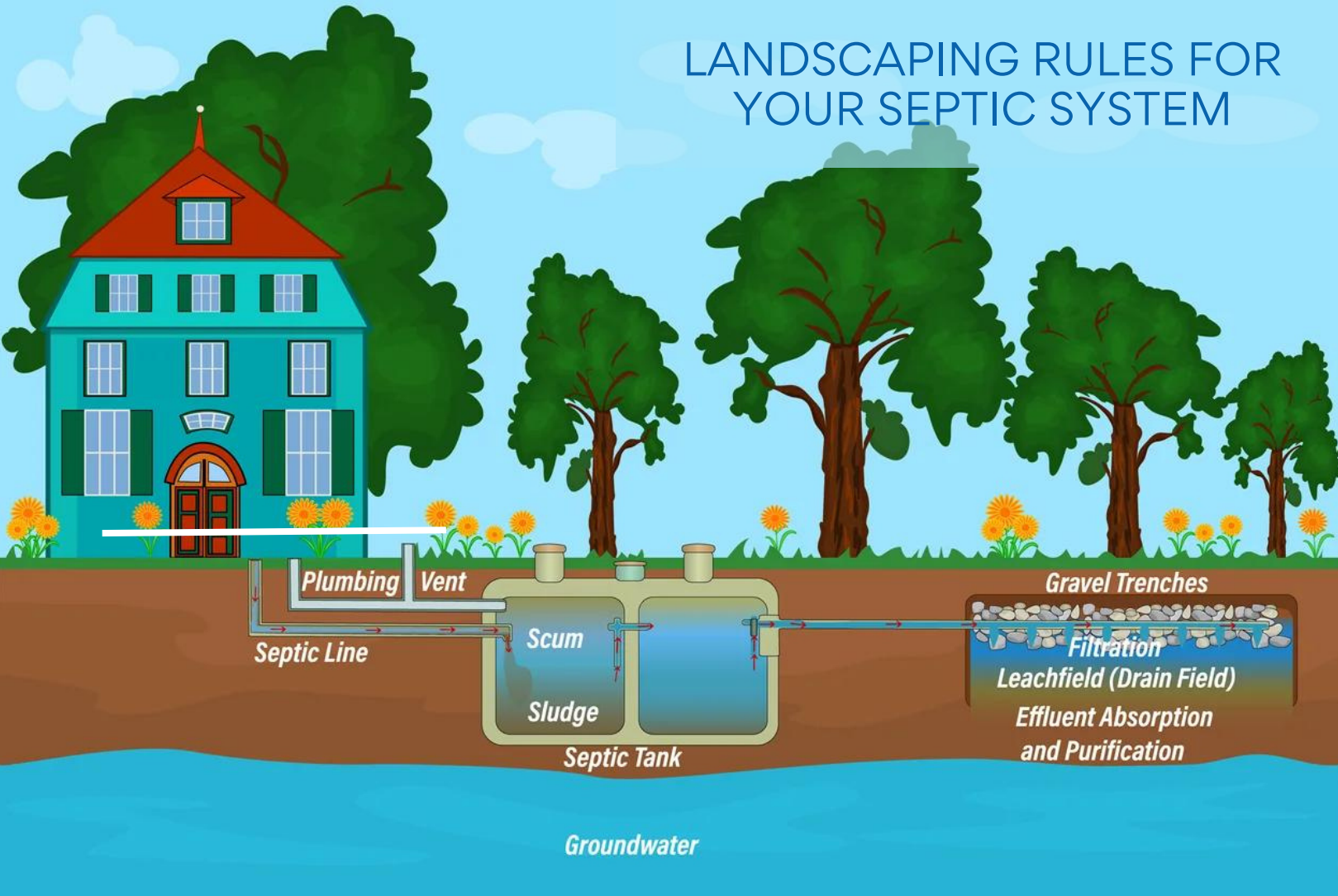


LANDSCAPING RULES FOR YOUR SEPTIC SYSTEM



Having the right landscaping on and around your septic system is important as trees and shrub roots can grow into the drain lines. Strong roots can cause the drainfield to fail. If your drainfield fails, your system will fail.

Investing in regular inspections and maintenance by a professional septic service minimizes the possibility of costly repairs.

- Avoid water loving plants & trees
- Don't plant vegetable gardens on or near the drainfield
- Do not create ponds on or near the septic system
- Do not put bark, gravel or other fill over the drain field
